

PART-TIME JOBS

Law Protects Teenager In Holiday Work

With the expected boom in retail sales, young people may have an opportunity for part-time employment during the holiday season, Regional Director Frank B. Mercurio of the U. S. Labor Department's Wage and Hour and Public Contracts Division pointed out in issuing a reminder of the Fair Labor Standards Act.

Mercurio said that the law permits boys and girls 16 and 17 years of age to work in an occupation which has been declared hazardous by the Secretary of Labor. Even 14- and 15-year-olds may work in a variety of occupations in retail stores, but only in establishments which are not engaged in interstate or foreign commerce.

During weeks when school is in session, they may work no more than a week, and only in certain types of occupations. These may be in a store, or in a restaurant, or in a cleaning service. Last year, the law found many 14- and 15-year-olds working in retail stores, in restaurants, and in cleaning services.

These are the jobs of driver or operator of a motor vehicle and of a power-operated machine, and of a frequently used operating and cleaning power-driven meat slicers or grinders.

In order to protect themselves against unintentional violation

of the law, employers should obtain and keep on file an age employment certificate showing the minor to be at least the minimum age for the occupation and the production of goods for commerce.

Mercurio reminded employers and young job-seekers that some jobs do not come under the Fair Labor Standards Act, since they apply to employees engaged in interstate commerce, in the production of goods for commerce or in certain large enterprises engaged in commerce or the production of goods for commerce. In these cases, the law requires that employers obtain and keep on file an age employment certificate showing the minor to be at least the minimum age for the occupation and the production of goods for commerce.

However, he said that each state also has its own labor law, and many of the standards are similar to those provided in the Fair Labor Standards Act. If the state and federal standards for the employment of young people differ, the higher standards should be observed.


